Description

Henry® Blueskin PreSeal™ 320 is a pre-applied, fully and permanently bonded composite sheet membrane system for waterproof construction. The membrane contains an adhesive and provides for mechanical attachment into wet concrete to form a permanent barrier seal. Blueskin PreSeal 320 consists of a polypropylene (PP) membrane laminated to a chemically enhanced non-woven geotextile fleece with a dimpled surface. Blueskin PreSeal 320 is pre-applied prior to rebar installation and concrete placement.

Usage

Designed for waterproofing of below ground structural concrete surfaces under continuous or intermittent hydrostatic pressure, **Blueskin PreSeal 320** provides protection of concrete from water and chemicals, and protection against gas permeation (e.g. radon). **Blueskin PreSeal 320** can be used in underslab applications and is immediately ready for placement of reinforcing steel. **Blueskin PreSeal 320** can be applied to permanent formwork including but not limited to lagging, sheet piling or caissons.

Application

Substrate Preparation: On all surfaces to receive **Blueskin PreSeal 320**, it is essential to create a sound and solid substrate to eliminate movement during the concrete pour. Substrates must be regular and smooth with no gaps or voids greater than 0.5 in. (12 mm). Grout around all penetrations such as utility conduits, etc. for stability. The substrate must be dry and clean of oil, dust, frost, bulk water and other contaminates that would limit adhesion of membrane. Substrates can be improved with concrete, plywood, insulation, or other approved materials to provide support to the membrane. Board systems such as timber lagging must be close butted to provide support and not more than 0.5 in. (12 mm) out of alignment. **Henry Drain Board** drainage sheet can be used to bridge voids, and gaps up to 2in. (50mm) prior to **Blueskin PreSeal 320** membrane installation.

Blueskin® PreSeal 320 Pre-Applied Waterproofing Membrane

Apply: Blueskin PreSeal 320 rolls are supplied in 3.3 ft. (1.0m) and 6.6 ft. (2m) wide with a selvedge on each side to provide self-adhered laps. **Blueskin PreSeal 320** must be installed with the smooth polypropylene side facing the potential water source and the dimpled surface facing the concrete pour side or facing the installer.

Horizontal Applications

Blueskin PreSeal320 membrane selvedge and tapes are manufactured with removable plastic release liners which must be removed prior to reinforcement and concrete placement. End laps should be staggered to avoid buildup of layers. Position succeeding sheets 2" (50mm) along the marked selvedge. Ensure that the underside of the succeeding sheet is clean, dry and free from contamination before overlap. Peel back the plastic release liner from between the overlaps allowing the two overlapped layers to adhere. Once completed, roll firmly with a heavy roller to ensure full bonding of the layers.

Vertical Applications

Blueskin PreSeal 320 can be applied vertically to permanent formwork or adjoining structures. After reinforcement placement, concrete should be cast directly against the dimpled surface geotextile side. The membrane must be shingle overlapped a minimum of 2 in. (50mm). All laps over cut edges must use **Blueskin PreSeal Tape 120V.** Vertically placed sheets can be attached to formwork with fasteners or using **Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S.** Fasteners should be placed in the selvedge approximately 0.5 in (12.5mm) from the edge of the membrane. When placing successive sheets, ensure that the underside of each succeeding sheet is clean, dry and free of contamination before attempting to overlap.

Refer to Blueskin PreSeal Installation Guidelines for detailed application information.

Limitations: **Blueskin PreSeal 320** is designed for maximum exposure of up to 120 days and is expected to be covered with concrete before that time. The membrane should be covered as soon as practical after application in order to minimize potential damage from other construction. For best results, **Blueskin PreSeal 320** should be installed in dry conditions. This system must not be used to cover expansion joints. Always protect the waterproofing membrane from possible damage. If membrane becomes damaged, contact the waterproofing installer or Henry before proceeding with concrete placement.

Blueskin PreSeal 320 is easy to clean and can be pressure washed to remove mud. A light broom or leaf blower can be used to remove nuisance debris.

Description

Henry[®] **925 BES Sealant** is a premium, moisture cure sealant for construction joints subject to dynamic joint movement. This one-part, low odor, moisture cure product provides excellent weathering resistance, flexibility, very low VOC, through use of a silyl-terminated polyether (STPE) polymer. Upon curing, it is paintable with latex based paints. This product is fully compatible with Henry[®] air barrier, flashing, roofing and waterproofing systems.

Usage

- Building envelope sealant for self-adhered air barriers
- External joint sealant for Henry® air barrier, waterproofing and roofing systems
- Alternative to silicone and moisture cure urethanes in above-grade construction applications
- Construction joints up to 1" (25 mm) width, subject to dynamic joint movement of ± 35%

Application

Surface Prep: Joints must be sound, smooth, uniform and free from defects and foreign materials. Joints must also be clean, dry, free of frost and all contaminants, such as curing compounds, sealers, or coatings. Sealant adhesion should be tested on each different substrate prior to use by applying a bead allowing to cure thoroughly. To test adhesive strength, pull one end of the bead.

Apply: Cut nozzle to desired bead size; puncture inner seal. Apply at a 45° angle while pushing sealant ahead of nozzle. The width of the joint should be a minimum of 4 times the anticipated movement. In joints up to ½" (13 mm) wide, the depth of the sealant should be equal to the width, but not less than ¼" (6 mm). In joints wider than ½" (13 mm), the depth should be maintained at ½" (13 mm). Maximum joint width for installation is 1" (25 mm). In vertical and horizontal joints, tooling is necessary to aid contact with the substrate and eliminate air bubbles.

Limitations: **Henry 925 BES Sealant** may be installed when substrate and air temperatures are as low as 10 °F. Application in temperatures between 10°F and 32°F may proceed only if the substrate is free of frost or ice. The product should not be applied in the rain or on wet surfaces; damp surfaces are acceptable.

If frost or ice is present on the substrate, it must be warmed to a temperature above 32 °F using hot air gun, heater, etc. to melt the frozen moisture. When installed in temperatures below 32 °F, an extended curing time is expected.

Prior to cold weather installation, **Henry 925 BES Sealant** should be stored at room temperatures above 35 °F for a minimum of 24 hours, to improve application and tooling.

Description

Usage

Surface Preparation: Clean substrates to receive Blueskin PreSeal Tape 120V and remove any dirt, dust or moisture. Clean the surface of penetrations or protrusions with a wire brush to remove dirt, dust, rust and loose particles.

Unroll the tape, remove the release liner, and adhere the exposed pressure sensitive adhesive surface to the membrane or penetration. The reinforced surface of the tape should face toward the concrete to be cast onto the tape. The use of rollers is required to maximize adhesion.

Description

Usage

Designed for commercial construction applications, **Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S** is used as a detailing accessory for **Blueskin PreSeal 320** and **Blueskin PreSeal 435** pre-applied waterproofing membranes. The **Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S** is used for attaching the **Henry DB** drainage composite or insulation boards to Henry waterproofing membranes.

Application

Surface Preparation: All surfaces to receive Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S must be dry and clean of oil, dust, frost, bulk water and other contaminates that would limit adhesion. Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S must be rolled firmly into place prior to removing the release liner. Ensure the release liner is then removed prior to adhering the next piece of membrane to the Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S which then must be rolled into place over the Blueskin® PreSeal Tape 50S detail tape. Refer to the Blueskin PreSeal PreApplied Waterproofing System Installation Manual and applicable system detail drawings at www.henry.com.

Henry DB drainage composite - Where Henry® DB drainage composites are placed horizontally from rolls onto a wall, a continuous strip of Blueskin PreSeal Tape 50S near the top and another strip near the bottom is recommended. If the drainage composite is cut and applied vertically in 6 to 8 ft (1.8 to 2.4 m) lengths, a strip is recommended near the top, another near the middle and a third near the bottom.

On decks, a strip of tape is recommended at approximately 10 ft (3 m) intervals, or more frequently in the event of high wind. Unroll the tape and adhere to the waterproofing membrane. Leave the release sheet on the tape until just before applying the drainage composite. The tape and release liner may be cut with a utility knife. Peel the release liner and apply the drainage composite. Press the composite firmly to ensure good contact. For deck applications, the tape may be applied to the back of the drainage composite rather than to the waterproofing membrane, if it is more convenient.

Description

Henry® Synko-Flex® Waterstop is a specially formulated non-swelling preformed joint sealant that provides a lasting, watertight bond to both fresh and cured concrete surfaces. It is a single component, self-sealing adhesive compound, extruded in a square cross-section between two quick-release protective wrappers. It bonds to cured concrete surfaces and fuses with fresh concrete during the hydration and curing process to achieve a watertight seal within cold joints at footings, walls and slabs on a wide variety of concrete structures. It does not rely on swelling to achieve its watertight seal, and therefore, it is unaffected by rain or wet conditions which may occur prior to joint completion.

Usage

Synko-Flex[®] is designed to provide a watertight seal of cold joints in a wide range of concrete structures including: residential and commercial basements, secondary containment structures, highway tunnels, concrete lined storm drainage and irrigation channels, pedestrian tunnels and below-grade walkways, swimming pools and water features, below-grade parking garages, waste-water treatment plants, fish hatcheries and aquariums, potable water reservoirs, and water theme parks. **Synko-Flex**[®]may also be used to seal around concrete, steel, PVC, or HDPE pipe penetrations through concrete walls or floor slabs. **Synko-Flex**[®]is also ideal for use as a joint sealant on precast structures such as box culverts, septic tanks and utility vaults.

Surface Preparation

Joint surfaces should be clean and dry before priming and just prior to placing the **Synko-Flex**[®] strips. Concrete should cure a minimum of 24 hours prior to priming. Ensure that concrete surfaces are free from form oils, release agents, curing compounds, laitance and other dirt or debris. Use a wire brush or stiff bristle brush to clean surface prior to priming.

Application

Positioning: Synko-Flex[®] is generally positioned in the center of the joint. It may be placed at the bottom of a keyway, if a keyway is incorporated into the joint design. However, a keyway is not required for the use of this product. Two inches of concrete coverage is recommended.

Standard Method: Apply primer to the cured surface and allow to dry. Drying time generally takes 2 to 3 hours. Drying time will take longer in low temperatures and in humid environments.

Peel the protective release paper from one side of the **Synko-Flex**® strip. Place the strip onto the primed surface pressing firmly along the entire length of the strip. The strip should be depressed to approximately 5/8 inch in thickness forcing it to widen to approximately 1-1/2 inches. Splice strips together with a 1-inch overlap or side lap. Remove the remaining release film. Fresh concrete may then be poured directly against the **Synko-Flex**®. The waterstop sealing system is complete when the fresh concrete cures.

In cold weather, both the **Synko-Flex**® strips and the concrete surface should be warmed just prior to application.

Alternate Application Method: Synko-Flex® may also be installed directly in the fresh concrete.

Horizontal Applications: Peel the protective release paper from one side of the **Synko-Flex**[®] strip. While concrete is still wet, carefully press the **Synko-Flex**[®] strips into the fresh concrete, leaving approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ inch exposed above the concrete surface. When concrete cures, remove remaining release film, and continue with pour.

Vertical Applications: Peel off release paper from one side of the strip, leaving the polyethylene release film on the formwork side of the **Synko-Flex**[®] to prevent the **Synko-Flex**[®] from adhering to the formwork and to keep the **Synko-Flex**[®] clean once the forms are removed. The **Synko-Flex**[®] is then nailed to the inside of the concrete form using small finishing nails. Chamfer strips (1/2") should be positioned on each side of the **Synko-Flex**[®] strip. Finishing nails will pull through the **Synko-Flex**[®] strips when end form is removed.

Limitations: Synko-Flex® is designed for use in non-moving or reinforced joints. Contact manufacturer regarding applications where limited movement could be expected.
